California, here we come

Calgary snowbirds heading south to enjoy Toscana Country Club MARTY HOPE Calgary Herald

Not all of Calgary's snowbirds are winging it to Arizona. California - and, in particular, the Coachella Valley with its nine population centres - attracts more than a few.

In the valley, Indian Wells, which is just outside Palm Springs, has the smallest population at about 5,000 residents.

It is also home to Toscana Coun-

try Club, an upscale, private equity residential country club that has strong,

traditional Italian -that's right, Italian and not southwestern - influences in its architecture and design.

It also has more than a little Calgary flavour as well, says Bill Bone, founder and CEO of Sunrise Co., which opened its sales centre, show homes and one golf course in 2004.

"The Canadian market is our second largest market, so it is extremely important to our continued success," he says.

RECREATION & INVESTMENT PROPERTIES

Indian Wells is a city in Riverside County, Calif., in the Coachella Valley in the Palm Springs area between Palm Desert and La Quinta.

As of last year, the city's population was 4,958. Located on the western slopes of the Coachella Valley, Indian Wells lies sheltered by the San Bernardino Mountains to the north, the Santa Rosa Mountains to the west and the Little San Bernardino Mountains to the east. The surrounding geography gives Indian Wells its hot, dry climate, with 354 days of sunshine and less than 150 millimeters of rain annually.

Winter temperatures average in the low 20s C with nights about 7 C, but the dry desert heat of summer pushes daytime temperatures well above 37 C, with overnight temperatures in the mid-to-upper 20s.

"We are fortunate to have a wonderful group of Canadian members and homeowners here at Toscana - 27 Canadians and 13 specifically from Calgary. They are extremely influential in their social and professional circles and continue to refer their friends, family and associates to buy here."

Toscana Country Club has a pair of Jack Nicklaus Signature, 18-hole golf courses that are surrounded by 652 homes and estate lots - and a 90,000-squarefoot Club Villa complex that includes dining facilities, a boutique, a spa and a sports club.

In terms of residences, there is a diverse collection measuring from 2,400 to 5,400 square feet- all with golf course views -with 18 floor plans and architectural elevations to choose from, including Early California, Italianate and Tuscan.

Private residences range in price from \$995,000 to \$7 million US and estate lots start at \$825,000, says an information sheet from the developer.

There are nine fullydecorated show homes to visit, as well as an expansive home design centre on site - with the services of a designer to assist purchasers.

To date, Toscana boasts 324 sales. Final build-out of 652 residences is likely another 10 years or so away, says Bone.

Referring to the struggling U.S. real estate market, Bone says that there has been a "renewed interest" in building new homes, and currently there are nine under construction with several more sched-

uled in the near future. In addition to the Canadian contingent on the property, Bone says there are many buyers from the Newport Beach/Los Angeles area and the Pacific Northwest.

"The majority of our buyers are between ages 55 and 60 who are looking for a close-knit club and community that offers them a strong social network with fun and interesting activities - along with a luxury home that meets their needs for entertaining

friends and family," he says. "We are very pleased with our sales results this year- so far in 2011, there have been 29 homes sold at Toscana - and we have had more than 1,300 guests through our sales centre and show homes."

IN SHORT Both resident and invitational (nonresident) equity golf memberships are available at Toscana Country Club A \$150,000 US initiation fee, plus monthly dues of \$1,595, provide access to all club facilities, two Jack Nicklaus Signature golf courses, and practice areas. A sports club and spa membership is also available for \$40,000 plus monthly dues of \$520, including access to all of Toscana Club facilities except golf. These include II Forno Trattoria, which offers indoor and outdoor dining, as well as a wine cellar available for private dinners and tastings. Spa Bella Vita and the adjoining Sports Club is a 28.000-square foot spa and fitness centre offering five luxury treatment suites and two grand treatment suites, a full-service salon, ladies and gentlemen's relaxation rooms and a spa boutique.
