1. What is the size of the Milano Series Homesite?

The typical Milano Homesite is 62.5 ft. x 160 ft. (10,000 square feet). Actual dimensions vary depending upon location.

2. Can I select an existing Amalfi homesite and build a 501 or 502?

Yes – the homesite price will be the current Amalfi homesite price.

3. Will there be West or South facing 501 or 502 homesites available with appropriate view premiums?

Not initially, however a West or South facing Amalfi Plan homesite can be purchased.

4. Are all the Design Center options available for this series home plan?

5. Are the 501 and 502 homes eligible for the deferred build program?

Yes. The deferred build program is available for this new series.
